AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

FUTURITY PRIZE MONEY

All monies from nomination and enrollment fees shall be pooled. The BHCA shall retain 30% for Expenses. The Balance shall be divided as follows:

Winners' Pool: 40% allocated as follows:

Best in Futurity: 66.6%

Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity: 33.4%

For all winner's prizes, the breeder or breeders of record will receive 100% of the total prize money. When there are multiple breeders of the winners of Best in Futurity or Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity, all futurity prize money will be given to the nominating breeder of the Best in Futurity and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity.

Classes: 60% allocated as follows:

- Prize money for each class is determined by dividing money from the total number of entries then multiplying by the number of entries in the class.
- If one entry in a class, it will receive 100% of the money.
- If two entries in a class, 1st will receive 60%, 2nd will receive 40%.
- If three entries in a class, 1st will receive 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%.
- If four or more entries in a class, 1st will receive 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10%.

FUTURITY CLASSES OFFERED

The futurity stakes entrants shall be eligible to compete in one of eight classes, divided by sex and age.

Dogs, Class I Bitches, Class I
(whelped: January, February, March 2018)

Dogs, Class II Bitches, Class II
(whelped: October, November, December 2017)

Dogs, Class III Bitches, Class III
(whelped: July, August, September 2017)

Dogs, Class IV Bitches, Class IV
(whelped: April, May, June 2017)

The winners of the eight classes above will compete for Best in Futurity and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity.

MATURITY CLASSES OFFERED

The Maturity Stakes entrants shall be eligible to compete in one of four classes, divided by sex and age.

Dogs, Class I Bitches, Class I
(Dogs & Bitches eligible from the prior 12-month (2017) Futurity competition who were born April 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017)

Dogs, Class II Bitches, Class II
(Dogs & Bitches eligible from the prior 24-month (2016) Futurity competition who were born April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2016)

The winners of the four classes above will compete for Best in Maturity and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Maturity.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog or breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
