Start out going east toward S State Route 31/IL-31
Turn left onto on S State Route 31/IL-31 and go about 0.3 miles
Take the US-ramp
Turn left onto Northwest Hwy/US- 14 W. Continue to follow
US-14W for 23.6 miles
Turn left onto W Brik St /IL-173. Continue to follow IL-173 for 3.3 miles
Turn right onto White Oaks Rd/ County Hwy 46 for 0.5 miles
Take the 1st left onto Hunter Rd/County Hwy -46. Continue to follow
Hunter for 13.6 miles
Hunter Rd becomes Elevator Rd. follow for about 0.3 miles
